TIMES AND PRICES: Enclosed, you will find the schedule of the day with practice times. Round one will begin at noon, and round two at 3:30 P.M. Price of admission is \$6.00 per round, with children under 5 admitted free. Programs will be \$1.00. Doors will open one half hour before rounds are to begin.

FLASH DRIVES AND MUSIC: You will need to bring your music on a good quality CD. They should be clearly marked with your team name and division. ACCOMMODATIONS: You and your team will be assigned a room for the day as well as a hostess. Please remember that these are classrooms and that our teachers think of them as their homes. Be a good guest!

Please do not use glitter! It is very difficult and time consuming for them to clean it up. We thank you very much for your consideration.

FIRST AID: We will have a trainer on hand during the competition. Please bring your own wraps, tape etc.

DRILL DOWN: There will be two drill down divisions, novice for the first year dancers, and advanced for all others. Awards will be given to the top ten in each division at the end of Second Round.

JUDGES: We will be having three judges. Please bring Flash Drive and announcer sheets with you to the coaches' meeting.

FOOD: Our concession stand will be open throughout the day with various goodies to eat and drink.

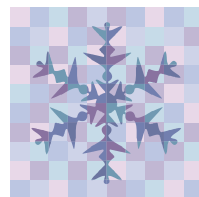
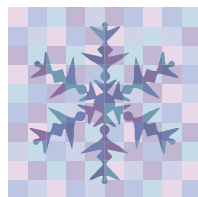
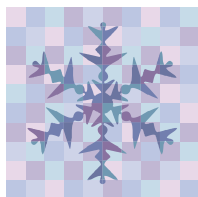
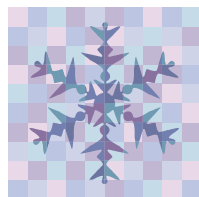
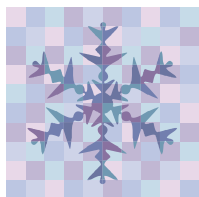
