

# JA Eval Show 2012

Location: West Linn High School – 5464 West “A” Street, West Linn, OR 97608

Driving Directions:

**From Oregon City, SE Portland:**

Take I-205 SOUTH

Take EXIT #8 (Lake Oswego/West Linn)

Turn RIGHT onto HIGHWAY 43

Turn LEFT at the first stop light, McKillican Drive

Continue driving to the top of the hill –the school is directly in front of you

**From I-5, SW Portland and Salem:**

Take I-205 NORTH

Take EXIT #8 (Lake Oswego/West Linn)

Turn LEFT on to HIGHWAY 43

Turn LEFT at the second stop light, McKillican Drive

Continue driving to the top of the hill – the school is directly in front of you.

**From Lake Oswego:**

Go SOUTH on HIGHWAY 43 past Marylhurst College

Turn RIGHT at the stop light at WEST "A" STREET

LEFT onto HIGHWAY 43

There aren't any landmarks to watch for. However, if you miss West "A" Street, you can turn RIGHT onto McKillican Drive.

West Linn High School will open for teams at 9:00 am. Please arrive no later than your check in time.

Parking: West Linn security will direct you on to the appropriate parking lot and entrance.

Props and Sets: Props and sets may be unloaded beginning at 9:00 am. Sets and props will be checked for floor protectors before you enter the gymnasium.

**Judging:** Please bring a clean flash drive with your school's name on it. Flash drives with any files other than previous judges' comments will be returned.

**Dressing Rooms:** We ask that you eat and drink only in the commons. There can be no food prepared, served or eaten anywhere in the school. Please do not use any equipment or materials in the room. Be aware the classrooms are carpeted; please take any necessary precautions to protect the floor.

**Parent Helper Passes:** Teams with 15 or less members will receive 3 parent helper passes. Teams with 16 or more members will receive 5 parent helper passes. Additional parent helper passes will be available for purchase at \$5 per pass for a total of 10 parent helper passes per team.

**First Aid:** A trainer will be available beginning with floor practice until the competition is over. Please bring your own supplies.

**Insurance:** It is assumed that each participant has personal or school insurance. West Linn High School, West Linn Dance Team, the West Linn - Wilsonville School District and the Judges' Affiliation will not be responsible for any injuries or losses that occur during the day.

**Concessions:** The concession stand will offer a wide selection of snacks during the event.

**Drill Down:** Novice and Advanced Drill Down will take place following the performances. Students should wear their performance costume or team traveling uniform and footwear appropriate for the drill down competition.

**Gift Table:** The gift table will offer a variety of items to have delivered to dancers.

## Rounds:

Round 1 – Each team will have 18 minutes with the judging panel in the practice gym. Coaches and dancers will have opportunity to meet with judges to get direct feedback on your routine. We suggest coaches meet with the Content and Overall Effect Judges while dancers meet with the Execution Judge. Dancers should be prepared to dance more than once. Dancers may wear practice wear or be in costume. No spectators are allowed during this time.

Bring your music, announcer sheet and flash drive to your Evaluation Session. We will not have a Coaches Meeting.

Round 2 – 5:30 p.m. (Gym doors open at 5:00 p.m.)

Cost:

Room Security: Each dancer must be wearing their costume, or team warm-ups to get into the team areas. This is for all of our dancer's security. Please inform your parents that we will not be allowing anyone (except coaches & parent helpers) in the team area for thirty minutes after the competition.

Music: Please bring a clean, clearly labeled copy of your music. A music person must be at the music stand during your team's performance. The music person should have a back-up copy in case there are any technical problems.
